01-09-22 Aylesham Industrial Estate - Sus Event. A remote Security Guard thought he saw intruders onsite at Channel Commercials. He saw them enter through the gate but couldn't confirm if they were staff or not. No Confirmed Offences.

01-09-22 Queens Rd – RTC failed to stop van v's car. No injuries.

03-09-22 Yodel Ratling Rd- Threats made to lorry driver, investigation ongoing for public order offences.

03-09-22 Station Field – Nuisance motorbike, off road bike riding around the station field. Dark Green bike and helmet, grey clothing. Call wasn't attended at the time due to call demand.

04-09-22 Akholt Rd – Male found lying on the verge, very drunk coughing up blood. SECAM attended. The male was aggressive with them and was collected by his cousin. (This wasn't the local homeless male)

04-09-22 Sunshine Corner Ave – Criminal Damage, eggs thrown at front door early ours of the morning.

04-09-22 Market Square - Elderly male fell, nasty cut to the head. Police were in the area at the time. SECAM attended.

05-09-22 Market Square – Assault in progress, Victim was assaulted whilst in his car. Offender was detained by members of the public until police arrived. Male was arrested.

05-09-22 – Coniston Drive – Obstruction, recovery Lorry parking near the junction. This was checked and deemed not an obstruction.

06-09-22 Hyde Place – Theft from motor vehicle. The vehicle was left unlocked. A male was seen on a ring doorbell over night, he entered the vehicle then removed a riding body armour, this was located at the end of the road. Crime report created.

08-09-22 Covert Road – RTC non injury, a vehicle clipped another when passing. The male from the offending vehicle chased the victim with some kind of tool, possibly a hammer. Crime report created.

08-09-22 Fife Way – Bin sheds broken into, homeless couple keep entering to sleep in there. Criminal Damage crime report created.

11-09-22 Cornwallis Ave – a young female had attended the shops, another young male approached her, he was abusive, so she left to go home, he followed her grabbed her phone and smashed it. Crime report created.

16-09-22 Ash Road – Sus Event, people and baggage swapping vehicles. Suspected migrants. Patrol attended. All was in order.

16-09-22 Newman Rd Carpark – Noise complaint for loud music, deep base music. Local Authority advice given for environmental awareness.

20-09-22 Train Station Field – Youth's lighting fires. This was noticed 2 nights in a row. Reactive Patrols carried out nothing found. No more reports.

22-09-22 Doorman Ave North – Vehicle fire, nothing suspicious driver noticed the vehicle getting hot, pulled over and the flames ignited. Possible faulty battery.

27-09-22 Cordale Rd – Parking complaints. A vehicle parked in the opposite direction to the flow of traffic. This is not an offence police can deal with.

28-09-22 Doorman Ave North – Parking Infront of a dropped curb. Patrol checked this. The vehicle in question wasn't in the spot reported. There were plenty of dropped curbs in the area to cross the roads.

30-09-22 Bevan Way – Criminal Damage, House brick thrown through a window after and argument between friends. Crime report created.

I have managed to get one of the off-road bikers summons to court. He was caught on the road in Nonington by me. After giving incorrect details, I very quickly had a name and address for him. One on my Special Constable Colleagues helped with getting him in for interview and submitting paperwork to the court. In total he committed 7 offences.
