
NHP Review - Case For Change

The organisation is facing significant future financial challenges for 2023/24.

- Previous saving initiatives focused on protecting front line resources
- Uplift funding is ringfenced by the Home Office to ensure increase of police officers
- Staff related savings options have always been a last resort and extensive work has been carried out to identify all other potential initiatives prior to this review






Dover – Crime & ASB By Volume




Dover – Crime by 1000 Population



Recorded Crime – East Kent


District & calendar year comparison





Dover – Recorded Crime




Dover – Crime Types By Volume



During Q3 FY 2022/23 Kent Police achieved the highest percentage (79%) of evidential casefiles submitted to the CPS that met the required standard out of all Police forces in England & Wales. National average was 59%

Deal & Dover – Tackling Violent Crime



March 23

As a result of a Dover CSU led Police investigation Roger Porter was identified, arrested, charged & sent to court where he was convicted & imprisoned for robbery.

December 22

Dover CSU working in partnership with DDC CCTV unit conducted an investigation that led to 2 youths being identified, arrested & charged with committing GBH with intent aggravated by use of a knife.

CCTV issued after multiple thefts from cars in Sandwich



April 23

... a spate of theft from motor vehicle offences in Sandwich led to an extensive Police investigation by the Dover CSU & VBC teams which culminated in an out of area suspect being identified, arrested, charged, sent to court & remanded to prison where he remains awaiting trial

... this suspect was responsible for like crimes all across Kent & the Metropolitan area, but it was only when he came to Dover district that he was brought to justice.
